

Called To Rescue also leads an awareness and prevention campaign to advocate for the protection of children victimized by abuse and work with local, state and federal authorities.

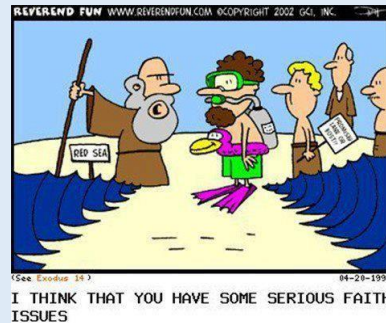
