

Arizona Governor's Prayer Breakfast

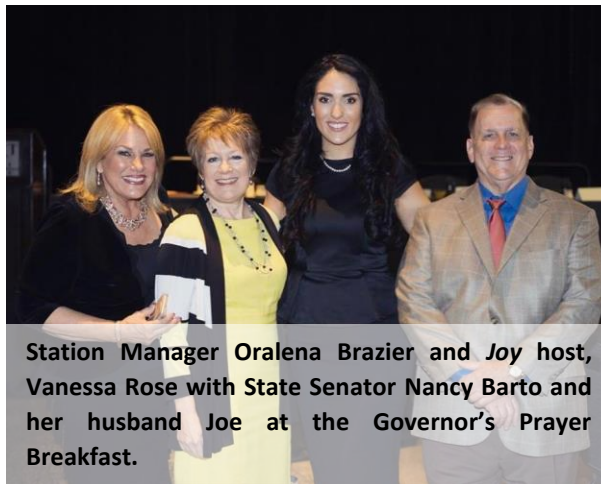

Joy In Our Town Production

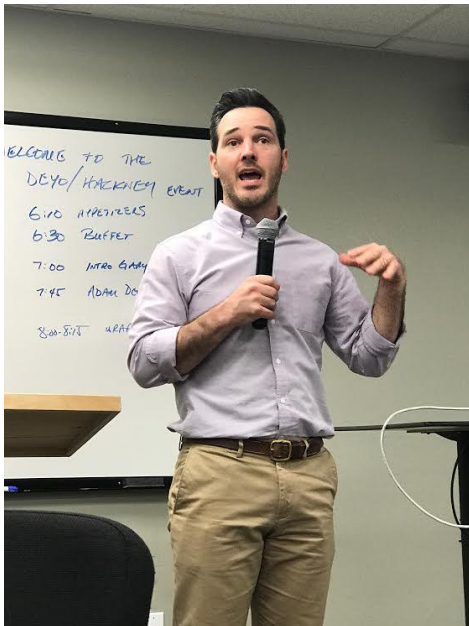
