Thank you Dolly for the volunteer work you do as our hostess for our public affairs program.

Master Sgt. Gary Knight, with the Oklahoma City Police Department, discussed with hostess Dolly Velasquez the problem of human trafficking in Oklahoma City. He



told us there are two types of human trafficking: labor trafficking which takes place more in other parts of the world and sex trafficking that is mainly what is in the United States and Oklahoma.



Ann Felton, CEO of central Oklahoma Habitat and Joy in Our Town hostess Dolly Velasquez visited about the habitat inmate program. The inmate program allows eight to ten inmates with non

-violent crimes to help with the projects of assisting in building homes for low income families. It gives the inmates a chance to see that people care and teaches them a skill before their release.

Donna Edwards, Executive Director of Living Well and host **Dolly Velasquez,** visited about the family and marriage—from war to peace and the difference between arguing and disagreement. The



subject was also discussed in relation to the family and children too. One main contributor to raising the intensity of arguing and disagreeing is the tone of voice. Watch the tone of voice, listen and if needed take a time out and come back at a set time. **Donna Edwards** and her husband do marriage counseling and group meetings.

Dr. Dale Peterson, wellness physician, and hostess **Dolly Velasquez,** discussed structural issues in our bodies. There are different components that our bodies; organs, biochemical and structural are just a



few. Often we treat structural issues biochemically rather than structurally. Some structural issues relate to three areas; hip misalignment, when it becomes slightly misaligned, the skull can slip slightly on the spine and our ribs can twist and lock up. One thing to remember is symptoms are warning lights and should be addressed not just medicated.

A lady from Cushing wrote in to let us know she has been watching TBN for years and how happy it makes her just hearing the Word. She is in a nursing home now and able to spend four or five hours praising God each day—saying she never knew what it was to really know Jesus so personally.
