The sun sets in Seattle as early as 4:15 pm during December. It's a vibrant city, still very much a pioneering city. Yet with the rain coming down day after day, the dreary overcast skies, and the early winter darkness, there is the temptation to let the dreariness affect you.

Then the sun breaks through and the joy of the Lord shines across the mountains and the waters. KTBW-TV and the many on-fire churches bring renewed hope. Jesus is here! In Him is life and the assurance that He is with us!

On the dark side, Seattle is the hub of sex trafficking in the Pacific Northwest. On any given night, 300-500 teenagers, mostly girls, are recruited to be sex slaves. They are transported up and down the I-5 corridor from Canada to Mexico, not knowing where they are. All they know is that if they don't bring in at least \$1,000 a night, they won't be given their pathetic dinner of chicken nuggets.

Ten years ago, Dianne Zoro's beautiful 17 year old daughter didn't come home. She had been recruited by sex traffickers. Dianne hasn't heard from her in all that time. But she hasn't given Up hope.

"I am a Christian," Dianne told our *Joy in Our Town* viewers. "My faith keeps me going. I know God has a bigger plan. I don't know what it is, but I've learned that I can still have joy in the midst of the sadness and pain. He is with me."
