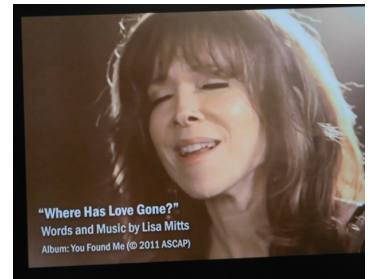
Only the healing power of Jesus Christ can transform a life broken by the forces of evil

Human trafficking is the second most lucrative crime in the world, behind drug trafficking. Seattle is in the top five cities nationally in terms of sex trafficking, largely due to the city's location on the I-5 corridor as well as being a major port city.

"Parents need to know that sex-trafficking is not just happenstance," Lisa said. "Recruiters and pimps are professionals. They are really good at what they do. They know how to target unsuspecting girls, how to entice them, and how to grab them into their systems."



To pimps, the girls are merely "inventory," to be sold to "johns" who are merely purchasing a product.

David and Lisa recently produced a music video, "Where Has Love Gone?" that graphically and powerfully illustrates the tragedy of sex trafficking. KTBW featured the video throughout the interview to illustrate the reality of what David and Lisa talked about on the program.

The average age of a victim in the U.S. is 13. Their life expectancy is only two to four years.

On KTBW-TV's "Joy in Our Town," host Tanny Jackson interviewed David and Lisa Mitts, Founders of Destiny House Restoration Center. This is the only vetted professional program in the nation, where girls who have escaped from this horrible slavery have an opportunity to have their lives transformed by the healing power of Jesus Christ. They hope to be able to replicate the Destiny House model so that other cities can use it to combat sex trafficking in their area.
