Community Involvement

A local mattress retailer in the Atlanta area was asking for donations of backpacks and school supplies to be given to needy families the last week of July. They had chosen three different urban project areas where there is great need for assistance. Some of the children cannot go to school because they do not have supplies. WHSG's station manager stopped by one of store locations and donated \$100 in the name of TBN. On the day that their trucks took the supplies to the projects, they had enough to give to over 500 school age children.
