Free Ultrasounds, a way to Preach the Gospel

Joy in Our Town Host Felicia Taylor interviewed Maria Kometer of Life on Wheels to talk about a mobile unit that goes into impoverished areas to assist pregnant women. Kometer said



that there are many good pregnancy centers in the Montgomery area but most of the women who really need them cannot afford them.

Impoverished pregnant women usually will not have the transportation, money and resources to know about them. "So Life on Wheels packs up the ultrasound in a mobile clinic and takes it right to them" she said. Dr. Matt Phillips, an OGBYN in Montgomery, came up with the idea after praying about how to help these poor women. He

partnered with pregnancy centers and learned about Image Clear Ultrasound Mobile. Across the country, the unit is considered safe, effective and a wise choice. The Life on Wheels concept is taken from the biblical model of Jesus Christ who, went to f ind those who were lost rather than wait for them to come to Him. This unit seeks out the needy and comes to the rescue. Kometer is passionate about the fact that this ministry uses modern technology to reach the hurting and the lost.
