The family/person may need assistance with any of the following:

- Assistance with job seeking which could include:
 - help completing the job application
 - ride to and from a job interview
 - calling businesses for information about opportunities
 - searching the classifieds in the paper or on-line
- Assistance when searching for housing, which could include:
 - how to call and speak to a potential landlord
 - completing rental applications
 - ride to and from apartment/house to meet with the landlord
- Transportation which could include:
 - to grocery store
 - drug store
 - medical appointments
- A friendly call to let them know that someone cares!
